

All Terrain Cane Instruction Manual

SAFETY SUMMARY

To ensure the safe operation of the Drive Canes and minimise the risk of injury, these instructions and safety precautions MUST be followed. If you are unable to understand the Warnings, Cautions or Instructions, contact a healthcare professional, dealer or technical personnel before attempting to use this equipment – otherwise, injury may occur.

GENERAL WARNINGS

The All Terrain Cane is a walking aid intended to assist those who have reduced mobility. This cane can provide ambulatory assistance for an individual weighing up to 113 kg (18 st). Over-loading the cane is the only known contraindication, although others may be specific to an individual or care environment.

Safety Precautions:

- Always consult a medical professional to determine proper adjustments and usage.
- Before using the cane, ensure that it is securely locked in place or a fall could result, causing bodily injury and / or damage to the cane.
- Not intended to support the total weight of the user.
- Not intended for use on ice or other slippery surfaces.

FEATURES

- Aluminium cane material
- Retractable stainless steel spikes for slippery surfaces
- Height adjustable between 76.5-99 cm (30-39")
- Foam hand grip
- Wrist strap
- Easy to wipe clean

PROPER CANE HEIGHT

For a more comfortable fit, ensure your shoe height is the same as the style of shoes worn most frequently when using the cane.



- Stand as upright as possible on a firm, flat surface and let your arm hang down naturally by your side.
- 2 Adjust the cane height so the top portion of the handle touches inside of your wrist, where it meets the palm.

The retractable spike section may need to be removed to fully adjust the cane to its lowest height.

HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

- Turn the anti-rattle collar ANTICLOCKWISE to loosen.
- 2. Press IN the snap button.
- Slide the extension up or down until the snap button protrudes through an adjustment hole on the handle end of the cane.

NOTE: An audible "CLICK" will be heard when the snap button securely protrudes through the adjustment hole.

- Repeat STEPS 2-3 until the cane is at height determined by PROPER CANE HEIGHT in this instruction manual.
- 5. Tighten the anti-rattle collar by turning CLOCKWISE.



PRODUCT CARE

- Inspect cane tips for wear and damage. Replace any broken, damaged or worn items or parts immediately.
 Part codes for the replacement tips are included in this manual.
- The retractable spikes may be removed for storage or to fully adjust the cane height. No other parts of the cane should be folded or dismantled during use, transport or storage.
- Ensure that the cane is securely locked in position, with the snap button fully protruding through the adjustment hole. The snap button should release and re-engage properly.
- The cane can be cleaned with a damp cloth and mild soap solution. Avoid neat bleach or abrasive surface cleaners. Leave to fully dry before reuse.

SURFACES AND RETRACTABLE SPIKES

The All Terrain Cane is intended for frequent indoor or outdoor use, and is designed for use on most surfaces and under most weather conditions. However, we recommend that particular care is taken on any unfamiliar surfaces.

To extend or retract the spikes, push the snap button near the tip and lock in position, similar to the HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT. Always check the tip of the cane is secure, ensuring the spikes are not loose.

To prevent damage to flooring, only use the steel spikes outdoors and retract when not in use.
