

2-STEP SAFETY LADDER

INSTRUCTION MANUAL



For correct usage, please read these instructions and the warning label before use and keep in a safe place for future reference.

SAFETY WARNING

When using ladders, basic precautions should always be followed, which include the following:

- Always inspect all parts prior to use ensuring all the screws are fixed securely. Check the steps and rungs of the ladder for wear and tear, and make sure they are strong and sturdy.
- When climbing the step ladder, make sure you do so facing the rungs of the ladder.
- Hold on to the hand rails when climbing the step ladder.
- Before using the step ladder, ensure it is completely opened up and the spreaders are locked into place.
- Please mind your hands when closing the ladder in order to avoid cutting or pinching your fingers.
- Do not place tools where they could move or fall and cause an injury.
- Always place the step ladder on even ground that has no obstructions. Floors should be clean, not slippery.
- Make sure that the step ladder is clean and dry before using it. Dirt and moisture can cause you to slip and fall.
- Make sure there are no hazards or other dangers in the area in which you are using the step ladder, for example, oil or water spillages.
- Wear suitable footwear (flat firm soled shoes) when using the ladder. Never work in high heels, bare feet, slippers or flip flops.
- Always stand with both your feet on a step.
- Check that there are no overhead hazards near where you are going to work.
- This product is for household use only.
- Never allow more than one person on the step ladder at a time.
- Do not exceed the maximum user weight of 135kg.
- Never carry items up the step ladder or overextend your body by leaning too far to one side. This can cause severe injuries if you lose your balance.
- Never work sideways.
- Close supervision is necessary when used near children.
- The step ladder is not to be used by children.
- Do not use the ladder if it is damaged. If you find any structural damage do not attempt to repair it yourself.
- Do not use the product for anything other than its intended use.
- Do not use the ladder as a bridge.

INTRODUCTION:

The 2 step safety ladder has front and side safety rails for reassuring extra support, stability, safety and confidence. Perfect for decorating, cleaning and pruning the garden, the uses are endless. The 2 side rails are complimented by oversized (38cm x 26cm/ 15"x10") non slip rubber trim steps and a extra high front safety rail which reaches 61cm (2ft) above the top step for additional support. With a maximum standing height of 48cm (19") from the floor, it measures H111.5xW47xD57cm when open and folds to H117.5xW47xD24cm. Maximum user weight 135kg (21st)


BEFORE USE

- Ensure all the screws and cap nuts are tight.
- Check the hand rail is securely fixed to the main frame if slightly loose retighten all screws and cap nuts before use.
- If any of the non-slip rubber trim is missing on the steps, it must be replaced before use.
- Make sure the steps are clean and dry.
- The ground should be firm and level.
- Remember to take it slow and steady when going up and down the ladder using the hand rails.

Note: Keep your stepladder protected from the weather in a covered, ventilated area. Never hang it vertically from one of the steps.

SETTING UP (Please see diagram below)

- 1 Remove all the contents from the packaging.
- 2 There are 2 holes in each end of the side safety rails.
- 3 Attach each one of the side safety rails to the main body of the step ladder using the screws, cap nuts and washers provided.
- 4 Place the side safety rail over the outside of the ladder main frame, ensuring the holes are aligned.
- 5 Insert the screw through the hole in the side safety rail and then through the ladder main frame, add a washer and cap nut, then tighten.
- 6 To secure both hand rails, repeat the same action for all for 4 holes: (A, B, C, D)
- 7 The ladder is now assembled.
- 8 When you open up the stepladder make sure the lock clicks into place lacksquare .



Note: The step ladder will support itself by spreading its weight and balancing through a scissor movement.

Folding the ladder away

Press down on the "PUSH" button to release the lock and fold away the ladder. (See diagrams below).
